

PEAR FLAN

Pastry:

200g plain flour

125g unsalted butter pinch of salt

pinch of salt

1 egg

1 tsp of baking powder

25ml cold water

Pear Filling:

5 pears in thin slices

1 tbs unsalted butter

1 tbs lemon juice

2 tbs sugar

Ingredients for topping: 125ml double cream

2 eag volks

egg yorks

2 tbs sugar

Heat oven to 170C/150C fan/gas 3 • Mix water, flour, butter, salt, egg and baking powder • Knead until it's soft and not sticky • Roll out dough on well-floured surface to 1cm thick • Place dough on a baking tray & prick bottom of tart with fork • Bake pastry in the oven for about 20mins • Make syrup by melting the butter with lemon juice & sugar in a small saucepan • Remove from the heat • When the tart bottom has chilled, lay the pear slices in concentric circles and sprinkle syrup over • Bake for 20mins until pastry is pale golden brown • Whisk together double cream, egg yolks & sugar until thick and creamy • When pastry is ready pour the cream over • Bake the cake in the oven for next 10 mins until mixture just set.


