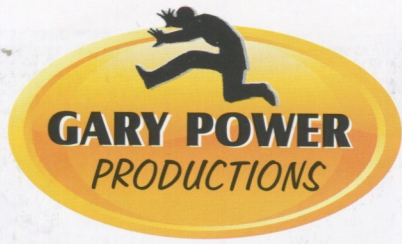

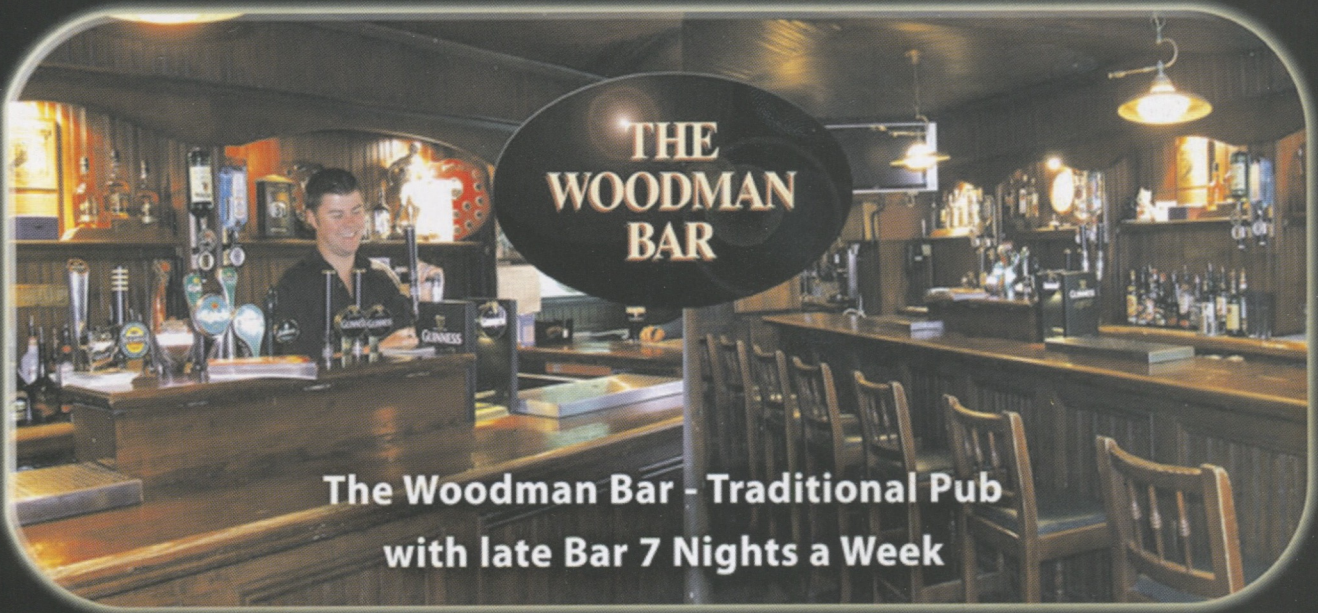

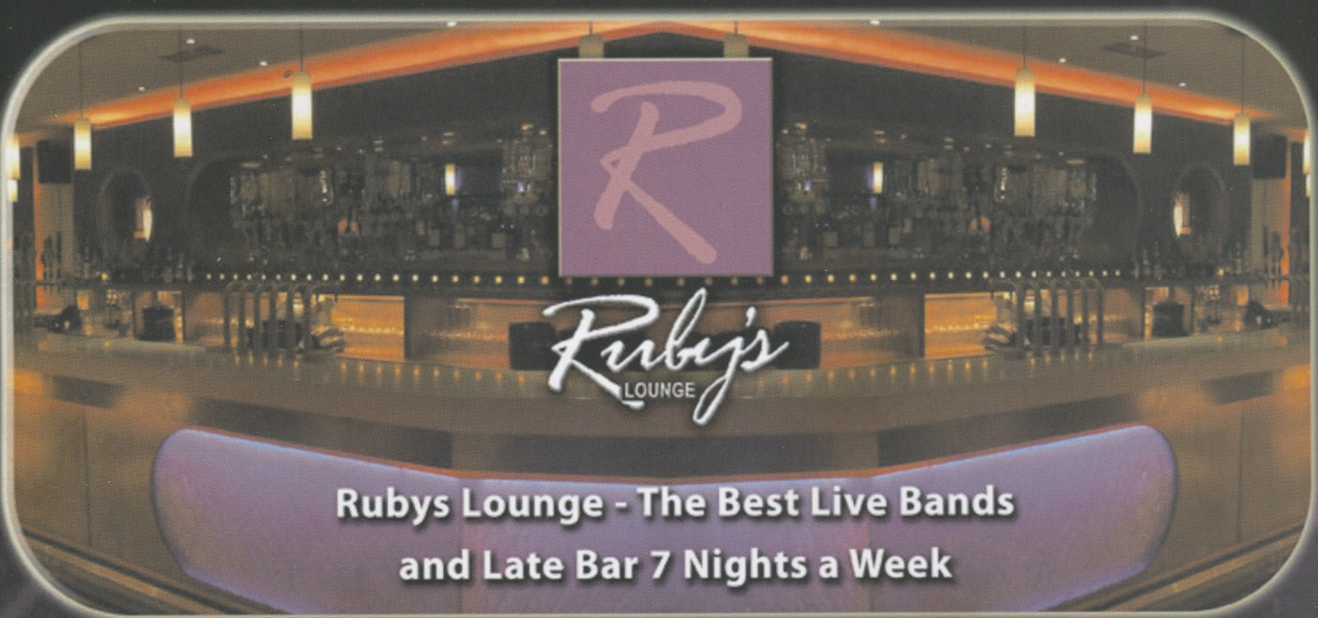

Vicki has just finished choreographing Little Shop of Horrors for De La Salle College.

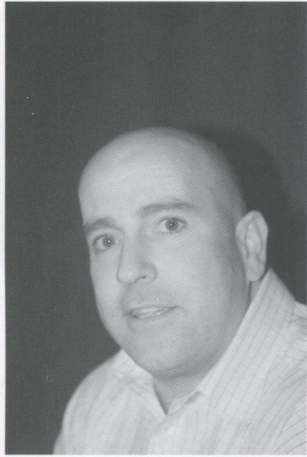
Always a fan of a good night out this show has proved to Vicki that there's no night out like a girl's night out!!

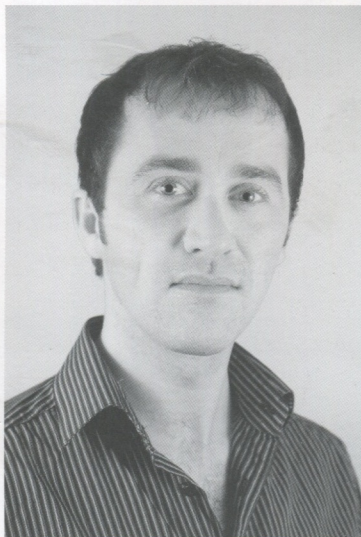

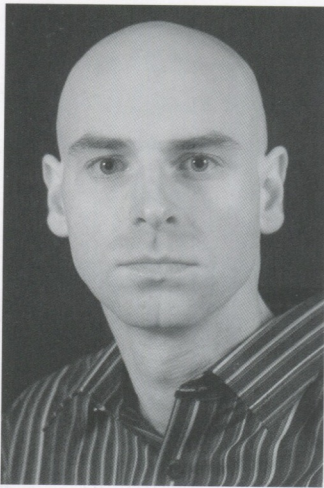
Fionnan "Fatz" Dunphy as *Billy*

Michael Quinlan as *Eddie*

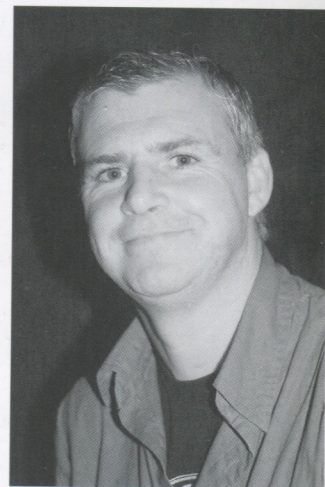
